We are now accepting consignments for our TDA Superior Genetics Whitetail Deer Auction on **Friday, August 21, 2009** at the Westin La Cantera in San Antonio, TX.

Please read carefully to review the UPDATED consignor protocol!

- ★ The August 2009 Texas Deer Association Superior Genetics Whitetail Deer Auction will consist of 100 lots. These 100 lots will be sold beginning at 1:00 p.m. on Friday, August 21, 2009. This is an OPEN auction. Each and every TDA member has an equal opportunity to sell and market their animals/semen in this auction.
- ★ Each deer breeder that is a TDA member in good standing may submit applications for up to two consignments. Consignors submitting two lots should label their consignments applications as first and second choice should only one lot be able to be in the sale.
- ★ If the total number of consignors is greater than 100, a random selection of 100 consignors will be made to select auction participants. The first choice application of these 100 consignors will be utilized in the sale.
- ★ If the total number of consignors is less than 100, each consignor will have their first choice application placed in the sale. The remaining lots, up to 100, will be randomly selected from the second choice applications submitted by consignors.
- ★ Semen consignments will be limited to no more than 10 of the 100 total lots. Semen consignors must fully complete the consignment application and pedigree chart.
- ★ Each of the 100 selected consignments will be scored using the enclosed scoring system developed by the Deer Auction Committee. The consignments scoring in the top 20% will be awarded "Blue Ribbon" status in both the auction catalog and at the day of the sale. Please spend some time reviewing the updated scoring protocol.
- ★ We encourage all potential consignors to submit the best deer and semen possible so that we can maintain the HIGHEST level of quality deer in the TDA Superior Genetics Whitetail Deer Auctions!
- ★ This sale will serve as a "Qualifier" for the 2010 TDA Select Sale. The top five dollar grossing live deer lots and the top five scoring Blue Ribbon live deer lots will qualify consignors to participate in the 2010 TDA Select Sale.
- ★ Delivery terms must be specific. They will be published both in the catalog and on the day of the sale.
- ★ Consignors must provide a picture of the consignment's sire for each lot consigned.
- ★ DONATIONS: Deer or any item can be donated for (1) TDA's Political Action Committee (PAC) to help TDA's legislative program, (2) Scholarships, or (3) TDA General Fund at any of our TDA auctions. Donation forms are available through TDA staff. Your donations help TDA to better serve our membership, support our youth and help protect the industry from unnecessary and costly regulations and legislation.

The deadline for pictures submission for the catalog is June 16th and August 15th for the slideshow.

Please read the Terms & Conditions of Consignment, complete the consignment application and sign it (if you need more than one please make a copy of the blank one) and return to TDA. **ONLY complete consignment application forms will be accepted.**

2009 SUPERIOR GENETICS WHITETAIL DEER AUCTION

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF CONSIGNMENT

Texas Parks & Wildlife currently restricts the shipment of deer into Texas and all buyers and sellers must comply with TPW current regulations. The laws and regulations in effect at the time of the auction will prevail.

Consignors: Must be a TDA member in good standing to consign and each licensed breeder is limited to the number of lots allowable for each auction.

Minimum or Reserve Prices: Minimum or "reserve" prices (PO prices) will not be utilized. If the seller does not desire to sell his/her lot for the last announced price in the auction he/she may "buy back" the lot by bidding on that lot in person at the auction, via a designated agent, via the internet simulcast or over the phone. The commission for seller "buy-backs" is 12% of the last legitimate bid as determined by the auctioneer.

Fees: Seller agrees to pay a \$150 consignment fee (check or credit card) at time of consignment submittal and a 12% commission to TDA upon completion of the sale. If any lot(s) are removed from the auction by the consignor after the catalog has been sent to the printer a \$150 management fee will be incurred.

Descriptions: All descriptions that appear in the catalog have been consequently described by the seller; TDA, neither auction manager nor the auctioneer assume any liability for any errors or omissions. **All reasonable efforts must be made by the seller to ensure the accuracy of the information provided for each lot consigned.*

Guarantee: Representations and guarantees are strictly between the individual seller and the buyer at the auction. TDA, the auction manager, nor the auctioneer make any representation of warranty, expressed or implied, on the deer or semen as to their merchantability or their fitness for general or particular purpose, and do further state the deer or semen to be sold "as is", and without recourse.

Possession: Seller will maintain possession of his/her deer or semen sold at the auction until delivered or buyer picks up the deer or semen and full payment is made.

Liabilities: All persons who attend the auction do so at their own risk and TDA, its employees and directors assume no liability, legal or otherwise, for any accidents or miscommunication that may occur.

Contract: The contract is between buyer and seller. TDA is the agent only. The seller is responsible for all permits. When the auctioneer says "SOLD", a contractual invoice will be submitted to the buyer for his/ her signature by a designated runner.

Delivery: Delivery of the deer or semen is solely between the buyer and seller and will be arranged according to the delivery terms provided by seller on the consignment form.

FOR SELECTING BLUE RIBBON (TOP 20%) CONSIGNMENTS:**

Category One - Score of Sire

10 Potential Points

(consignor selects non-typical or typical on pedigree chart)

Non-typical Gross (1 to 10 points based on benchmarks below)
(210+, 220+, 230+, 240+, 250+, 260+, 270+, 280+, 290+, 300+)

OR

Typical Net (1 to 10 points based on benchmarks below)
(170+, 175+, 180+, 185+, 190+, 195+, 200+, 205+, 210+, 215+)

Category Two - Score of Paternal Grandsire

5 Potential Points

(consignor selects non-typical or typical on pedigree chart)

Non-typical Gross (1 to 5 points based on benchmarks below)
(180+, 200+, 220+, 240+, 260+)

OR

Typical Net (1 to 5 points based on benchmarks below)
(160+, 170+, 180+, 190+, 200+)

Category Three - Score of Maternal Grandsire

5 Potential Points

(consignor selects non-typical or typical on pedigree chart)

Non-typical Gross (1 to 5 points based on benchmarks below)
(180+, 200+, 220+, 240+, 260+)

OR

Typical Net (1 to 5 points based on benchmarks below)
(160+, 170+, 180+, 190+, 200+)

Category Four – Score by Age

5 Potential Points

1 point given (up to five points) for each buck on pedigree that scored greater than 165” at one year old or greater than 200” at two years old.

Category Five – “Super Does”

10 Potential Points

2 points given (up to ten points) for each doe in pedigree that has a 220+” gross or 190+” typical son.

Category Six - DNA registration on Sire side of consignment pedigree

5 Potential Points

1 point given (up to five points) for each deer on sire side of pedigree that is registered with NADR.

Category Seven - DNA registration on Dam side of consignment pedigree

5 Potential Points

1 point given (up to five points) for each deer on dam side of pedigree that is registered with NADR.

Category Eight - Texas Genetics

5 Potential Points

1 point given (up to five points) for each deer in pedigree that is born in Texas. Ancestry only examined through grandsires.

Category Eight – Semen Donor Buck (For SEMEN LOTS ONLY)

5 Potential Points

(consignor selects non-typical or typical on pedigree chart)

Non-typical Gross (1 to 5 points based on benchmarks below)

(200+, 220+, 240+, 260+, 280+)

Typical Net (1 to 5 points based on benchmarks below)

(170+, 180+, 190+, 200+, 210+)

There is a maximum Blue Ribbon score of 50 available to any live deer lot. Maximum Blue Ribbon score for semen lots is 55. Semen lot scores will be reduced by a multiplier of .90909 (50/55) to compare equally with deer lots. The top 20% of consignment applications accepted {including ties} will be awarded Blue Ribbon status.
